OVERVIEW

The Reuse Network is a reliable, cost-effective, and turnkey solution for disposal of excess furnishings and equipment. Combining reuse and recycling, we ensure that unneeded furniture is kept out of the waste stream, and remains in use for as long as possible.

The Reuse Network matches furnishings with a network of more than 400 nonprofit organizations. Many need furnishings to support community development and poverty relief here in the U.S. Others need furnishings to rebuild communities ravaged by earthquake, flood, hurricane, war, or other natural or social disaster, in the U.S. and worldwide.

PROCESS

Inventory: You send us a list and photos of the items you need removed. These allow us to calculate costs, and make a match with the best recipient.

Labor: Many of our clients have regular movers or installers. Others ask The Reuse Network to provide labor. We're comfortable either way.

Proposal: We give you our cost before you agree to use our services. Ours is a not-to-exceed proposal covering all the services you ask of us.

Schedule: With you, we set the date(s) for the removal: when the crew and trailers will arrive, how many trailers will be loaded each day.

The Project: We have an IRN manager onsite to supervise and troubleshoot. Trailers arrive; the move crew empties your building(s) and loads the trailers; the trailers drive away. We set aside and recycle/dispose of all items that are unsuitable for reuse. We leave your premises empty and clean.

Followup: We provide a detailed conclusion report, suitable for LEED or other Sustainability reporting, documenting exactly what we've taken away, where it's gone, and total landfill diversion.
