# Case Study in Reuse Fort Worth Independent School District

#### Overview

Voters in the Fort Worth, Texas Independent School District approved a \$750 million capital improvement program, with the goal to enhance learning environments in the district's twelve high schools. These projects have added or expanded Career and Technical Education spaces, science classrooms, libraries, and collaboration spaces, and have eliminated the district's reliance on several dozen portable classrooms.

Installation of new furnishings and removal of the old have been closely tied to the schedule for renovations and new construction undertaken in many of the schools. It's been a complex project with many moving parts, extending (to date) over four years, with the many disruptions of Covid-19 thrown into the middle.

Based on a decade-long partnership, the District's new furniture supplier proposed reuse of the old furnishings as part of its service package. Considering the financial, environmental, social, and operational benefits, the district agreed that reuse was the best option for handling the furnishings to be disposed of.

## Composition

IRN's involvement to date has included 20 separate reuse projects, ranging from 275 to more than 1,600 pieces, and providing 43 tractor-trailers filled with furniture to needy communities.
